Encaustic Art Examples

Lynn has been working with encaustic since 2000. Since beginning painting onto the white painting card she has moved on to incorporate encaustic onto different surfaces and mixed it with other art forms. These are a few samples of what can be achieved.









These 4 paintings have all been painted onto the white painting card













The triptych is painted onto canvas ~ The waterfall on card with wool forming the waterfall ~ The fantail was painted on card and heat transferred to silk then over painted with fabric paint ~ The cabbage tree is painted directly onto the back side of a piece of glass















A range of bags & containers using various fabrics (including silk "paper"), incorporating embroidery and encaustic techniques













A sample of thinking outside the square, parcel made of paper mache, candle out of toilet roll cores!, cardboard shoe and a couple of pots incorporating fabrics, beads, etc., along with encaustic wax paints
